Subject: Banning of import of bovines into UT of J&K and inter-District movement of bovine animals in view of spread of Lumpy Skin Disease.

Government Order No: 227JK(APD) of 2022
Dated: 22-09-2022

In the wake of spread of Lumpy Skin Disease (LSD) in UT of J&K and some States of the Country, as a measure of abundant precaution and in view of declaration of whole UT of J&K as "**Controlled Area**" for Lumpy Skin Disease vide S.O 424, dated 05.09.2022 and in exercise of powers conferred under Section 10 of the Prevention and Control of Infectious and Contagious Diseases Act, 2009, Government of UT of J&K extends complete ban on import of bovine animals from neighboring States and inter-District movement of bovines within UT of J&K for any purpose, till 25.10.2022. The decision will be reviewed on the basis of evolving situation.

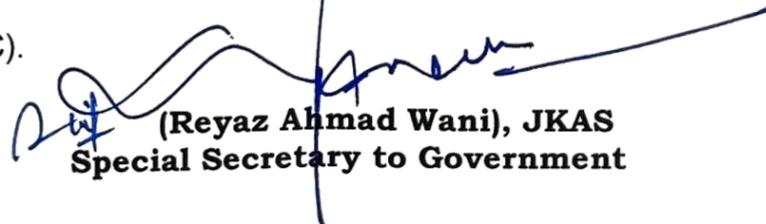
